

David Hobhouse has drawn attention to an unrecorded ancient site on the north shore of mid Loch Fada, perhaps formerly an island. It seems to be about 22ft in diameter, stands to about 18" in height, and the "circle" is slightly distorted by an entrance due east and slightly wider than a normal doorway. Stones in the interior might be a fire back flanked by tumble .... but could also form some sort of partition, about one-third in from the eastern end.
